GC is located in downtown of beautiful Vancouver providing easy access to local amenities and city transportation, such as the Skytrain and main bus routes. Our campus offers a positive and real-world learning environment with advanced laboratory, comfortable classrooms, library and study areas. Gateway College graduates are working as valuable members of the health-care teams in private and public hospitals, long-term care, complex care, assisted living, independent living, special care, palliative care facilities and home support agencies.

Programs

Health Care Assistant

This program is designed to train students to become Health Care Assistants (HCAs). Our dedicated and experienced instructors will provide quality education with hands-on training to prepare students for the real-world health care scenarios. Students will practice their techniques in labs equipped with articulated mannequins, hospital beds, medical gear, and fixtures. Furthermore, students will participate in a designated facility or a hospital and interact with patients throughout the practicum training period. This training will help students learn proficiency and the confidence most needed on a job. Our graduates work as HCAs in both private and publicly funded facilities and hospitals as well as a variety of community settings. HCAs work as part of a team within a health care unit under the supervision of a health care professional such as a Registered Nurse or Licensed Practical Nurse.

Gateway College offers variations of HCA program to suit the various needs of students:

HCA & Communication (Year 1 & Year 2) is recommended for International students with or without any background in healthcare. HCAC Year 1 is purely English Language training for International students to prepare them for English Language Benchmark Tests e.g. IELTS. HCAC Year 2 consists of comprehensive training in Medical Terminology & Communications in Health Care and Essential Skills for caregivers in Canadian healthcare to kickstart the HCA training. International students with having met the English Language Requirements can apply directly for Year 2 of this program.

HCA (33-week Program) is best suited for students who are working or have other commitments as the courses are delivered at a slower pace with combination delivery option (in-class + online) which allows flexibility in schedule.

HCA-Accelerated Program is a fast track option for students who can devote more time to studies in a fewer number of weeks and complete the program in less than 6 months.

HCA-Access Program is more suitable for students who have prior healthcare learning or work experience; have undergone the assessment by BC Care Aide Registry and have a remedial letter, or would like to refresh or update their skills and knowledge to meet and exceed the BC Provincial Standards.





Programs

Enhanced Skills Program – Geriatric Care (ESP-GC) with Co-op

This program is designed to enhance the knowledge and skill of learners to work with older adults in order to effectively meet the needs of the aging population. This program will focus on gaining a greater understanding of the physical, social, cognitive and spiritual needs of the older adults, and the challenges faced by our aging population. Our dedicated and experienced instructors will provide quality education with hands-on training to prepare students for the real world. Students will practice their techniques



in labs equipped with articulated mannequins, hospital beds, medical gear, and fixtures. Furthermore, students will participate at a designated facility or

a hospital and interact with patients throughout the practicum training period and 12 weeks of Co-op period. This training will help students learn proficiency and the confidence most needed on a job. Our graduates work in both private and publicly funded facilities and hospitals as well as a variety of community settings that includes extended care, intermediate care, assisted living, acute care hospitals, home support, rehabilitation facilities and group homes. HCAs work as part of a team within a health care unit under the supervision of a health care professional such as a registered nurse or licensed practical nurse.

Post Graduate Diploma in Nursing Practice (PGDNP)

This program is designed to prepare Internationally Educated Nurses (IENs) to adapt to Canadian health care setting and prepare for LPN/RN Licensing and registration exams. PGDNP program also trains the students as HCA so they can register and start working in healthcare setting as HCAs while they study the PGDNP program with us. Students get Health Care Assistant (HCA) training, CELBAN training and training to take RN/LPN Licensing and registration exams under this Program. They take theory



classes, lab training, practicum at complex care facility & assisted living facility (with option for Co-op).

Program Variation (PGDNP with CO-OP)

PGDNP program is also offered with Co-op option. This is highly recommended for students who would like to gain work experience before they graduate through the program.

International students are encouraged to take this program with Co-op option to allow sufficient time for the process of obtaining their Nursing Practice License in Canada.

Admission

Required Documents

Please ensure that all documents are submitted to the college in time to allow sufficient application processing time before the program start date. International students are encouraged to apply and submit paperwork as soon as possible to allow time for study visa processing from their relative countries.

- Completed "Appendix 1" and "Appendix 2"
- Application Fee (non-refundable)
- Secondary School or Post-Secondary Diploma & Transcripts (not applied to mature students*)
- ▶ Photocopy of Picture ID (passport or Driver's License)
- Proof of Language Proficiency
- Criminal Record Check Report
- * Applicants must be at least 19 years of age prior to the start of the study period or graduation from grade 12 (or equivalent).
- * Please note that meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to Gateway College.

International Students

Gateway College offers a variety of services to help students get settled in their new home. Conveniently located in the center of Vancouver, we provide services for airport pick-up, homestay, assisting in student visa & Canadian Customs, acquisition of English language skills, and much more.

Although it is easy to travel outside of Vancouver on weekends, students find there are many reasons to stay in the city – biking, hiking, paddle boarding, outdoor movie theatres, night markets, parks, beaches, community events to cultural festivals, there are entertainment options to match everyone's interests. Gateway College provides information on numerous cafes, cinemas, theatrical productions, concerts, outdoor activities and special events throughout the year.

Medical Health Insurance

Gateway College requires that all international students have basic health insurance and BC Medical Service Plan (MSP) for the duration of their studies. If your family members are in Canada, they should also have insurance for the duration of their stay. All international students will be automatically enrolled for basic health insurance plan when they register for programs. This plan covers the first three months from arrival in Canada, plus up to 10 days of travel between your country and Canada. All international students must apply for BC Medical Service Plan (MSP) if they stay in BC for more than 3 months. There is a three-months waiting period, so students must apply as soon as they arrive.

Immigration

International students are responsible for obtaining required immigration documents and maintaining their immigration status while studying in Canada. Required immigration documents for most international students to study at Gateway College include valid passport, temporary resident visa (TRV), study permit, and/or co-op work permit if applicable. Citizens of visa-exempt countries do not require a TRV to travel to Canada.
